When and where is Garage Days?

Garage Days is on Saturday 6 February 2027, from 3 pm to 10 pm, at Richard Hamilton Wines, McLaren Vale, South Australia.

Where can I buy tickets?

Tickets will be available through the official Garage Days Eventbrite page. We recommend buying only through the official ticket link.

Is Garage Days an all-ages event?

Yes, all ages are welcome. Under-18s must be with a responsible adult at all times. Garage Days has loud music, crowds, alcohol and possible explicit language, so parents and carers should decide if it's suitable for their children.

Do attendees under 18 need to be accompanied by a responsible adult?

Yes. Every attendee under 18 must enter with a responsible adult who has a valid event ticket and remain in that adult's care throughout the event. Under-18s cannot enter or leave the festival on their own. Entry may be refused if an under-18 attendee arrives without their responsible adult.

What do you mean by a "responsible adult"?

A responsible adult is a parent, guardian or another adult aged 18 or over who has permission to look after the young person. They must stay with them throughout Garage Days and be able to care for them safely.

How much are children's tickets?

Tickets for children aged 12 and under are \$49 plus booking fees. For any other questions about children attending Garage Days, please email info@thebigparty.com.au.

Can an under-18 attendee buy or drink alcohol?

No. Alcohol will only be served to adults aged 18 and over. Age checks may take place, and under-18 attendees must follow any restrictions on licensed areas.

Can I bring a baby or toddler?

Babies and toddlers are welcome with a responsible adult, but Garage Days may be too loud and busy for little ones. If you bring them, please consider their comfort and use suitable hearing protection.

Is there a VIP ticket option?

Yes! VIP tickets start at \$229 plus booking fees and include an express event entry lane and access to a private 18+ area with a dedicated bar, private toilets and seating with shared tables. Capacity is limited, so book early to avoid disappointment.

Can I get a companion ticket?

Yes. Please purchase your own ticket, then email info@thebigparty.com.au with the subject "Request for companion ticket". Include a copy of your ticket and a clear copy of your valid Companion Card so we can arrange the complimentary companion ticket.

Can I leave and re-enter the event?

No. There are no pass-outs at Garage Days, so you won't be able to re-enter once you leave. Please bring everything you need to stay comfortable throughout the day.

Is parking available on site?

Limited parking is available on site. You'll need to pre-purchase a car or bus parking ticket through the Eventbrite ticketing page. Spaces are limited, so please book early to avoid disappointment. Accessible parking is free on presentation of a valid disability parking permit.

Will there be festival buses?

Yes! Festival buses will run from several pickup points around Adelaide and the local area. We'll share routes, prices and a booking link when bus tickets go on sale soon.

Can I bring my own food and drinks?

You may bring snacks, but no alcoholic or non-alcoholic drinks can be brought into this fully licensed event. Bring a clear, empty water bottle of up to 1.25 litres to refill at the hydration station. Supermarket-sized cooler bags are welcome and will be checked at entry. You may bring ice to keep b

Will food be available at Garage Days?

Yes! Local food vendors will serve a range of meals, including vegan, vegetarian and gluten-free options.

Will there be seating and shade?

Seating and shade are not provided in the General Admission area. You're welcome to bring your own chair or picnic blanket. Please dress for the weather—a wide-brimmed hat and long-sleeved shirt can help protect you from the sun. Seating is provided in the VIP area.

What happens if it rains?

Garage Days is an outdoor event and will go ahead rain, hail or shine. If dangerous weather affects the event, we'll share updates through our official channels.

Is the site accessible?

We want Garage Days to be accessible to as many people as possible. The festival is outdoors at a winery, so some ground may be uneven. If you have specific access requirements, email info@thebigparty.com.au before the event so we can discuss the available arrangements.

What should I bring to make the day seamless?

We'll send ticket holders a list of essentials and prohibited items closer to the event. For now, plan for a day outdoors and bring your ticket, a wide-brimmed hat, sun protection and a clear, empty water bottle of up to 1.25 litres.
